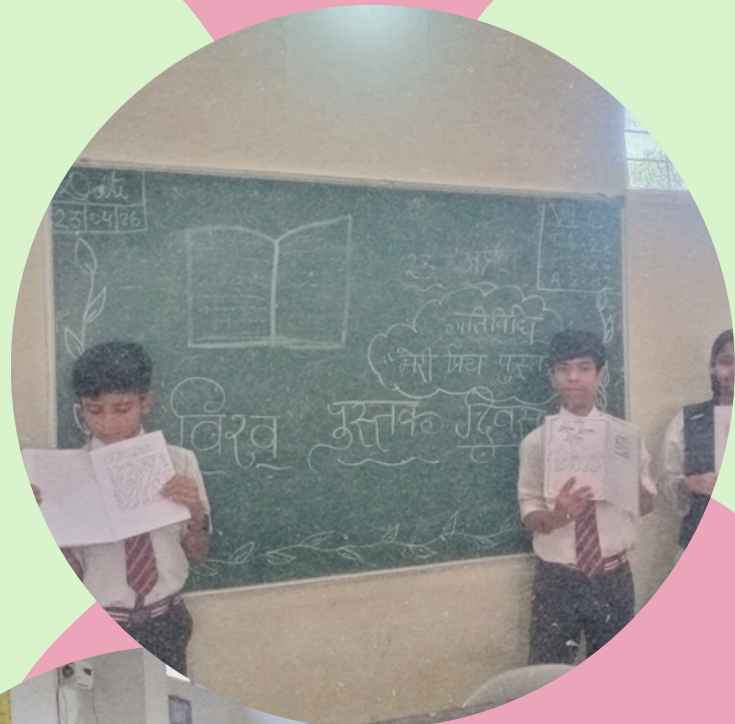
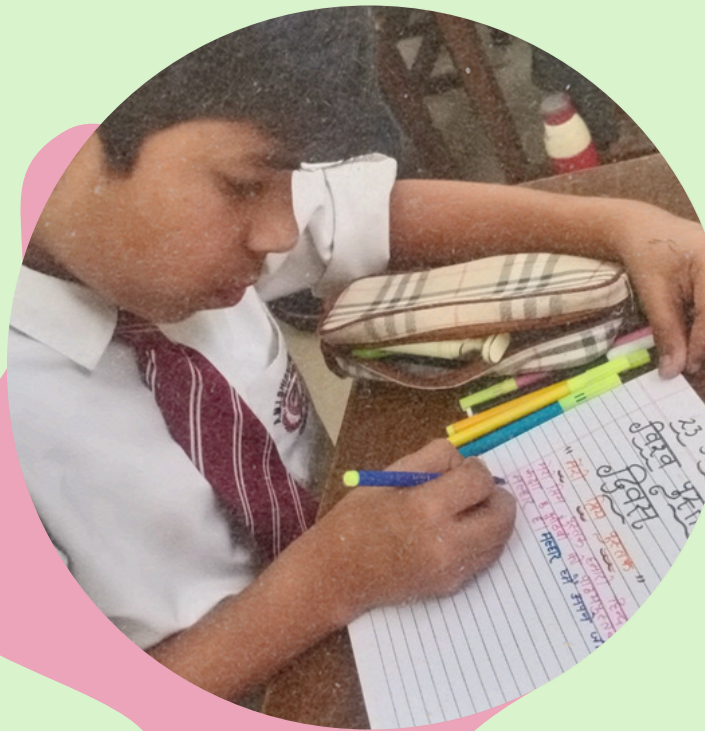
# विश्व पुस्तक दिवस

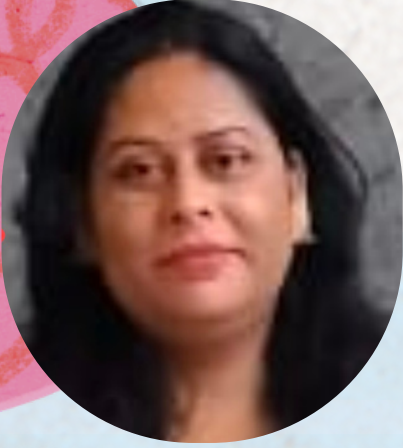

# अंतर्राष्ट्रीय नृत्य दिवस



अंतर्राष्ट्रीय नृत्य दिवस (INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY) की शुरुआत 29 अप्रैल 1982 से हुई थी। यह हर साल 29 अप्रैल को मनाया जाता है, जिसे युनेस्को के अंतर्राष्ट्रीय रंगमंच संस्थान (ITI) की नृत्य समिति द्वारा आधुनिक बैले के निर्माता जीन-जॉर्जेस नोवेरे (JEAN-GEORGES NOVERRE) के जन्मदिन के उपलक्ष्य में स्थापित किया गया था। यह दिवस हर वर्ष 29 अप्रैल को मनाया जाता है, जिसका उद्देश्य नृत्य की कला को बढ़ावा देना और लोगों को इसके महत्व के प्रति जागरूक करना है। नृत्य केवल मनोरंजन का साधन नहीं है, बल्कि यह हमारी भावनाओं को व्यक्त करने का एक सशक्त माध्यम है। जब शब्द कम पड़ जाते हैं, तब हमारे भाव नृत्य के माध्यम से प्रकट होते हैं। नृत्य हमारे शरीर, मन और आत्मा को जोड़ने का कार्य करता है।

भारत जैसे विविधताओं से भरे देश में नृत्य की अपनी एक विशेष पहचान है। भारत में आठ शास्त्रीय नृत्यों को मान्यता प्राप्त है यहाँ भरतनाट्यम (तमिलनाडु), कथक (उत्तर प्रदेश), कथकली (केरल), मोहिनीअट्टम (केरल), कुचिपुडी (आंध्र प्रदेश), ओडिसी (ओडिशा), मणिपुरी (मणिपुर), और सत्रिया (असम)। जैसे शास्त्रीय नृत्य रूप हैं, तो वहीं भांगड़ा, गरबा और लोकनृत्य हमारी संस्कृति की जीवंत झलक प्रस्तुत करते हैं। हर नृत्य शैली अपने आप में एक कहानी कहती है।

नृत्य कला का प्रारंभ 200 ईसा पूर्व से 200 ईसवी पूर्व माना जाता है इसका आधार भारत भूमि का नाट्यशास्त्र है एवं भरत मुनि का नाटक शास्त्र भगवान नटराज के नृत्य से प्रेरित है।

नटराज (भगवान शिव का नृत्य रूप) का नेट (ब्रह्मांड या इंटरनेट/संसार के जाल) में मुख्य भूमिका सृजन, स्थिति और संहार के ब्रह्मांडीय संतुलन को दर्शाना है। चोल काल (9वीं-11वीं शताब्दी) से प्रचलित यह स्वरूप सिर्फ कला नहीं, बल्कि आध्यात्मिक और वैज्ञानिक अर्थ भी रखता है।

नृत्य न केवल हमें स्वस्थ रखता है, बल्कि आत्मविश्वास भी बढ़ाता है। यह अनुशासन, समर्पण और कड़ी मेहनत का प्रतीक है। आज के समय जीवन भागदौड़ से भरा हुआ है, नृत्य हमें तनाव से मुक्ति दिलाने का बेहतरीन साधन है।

अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय नृत्य दिवस हमें यह सिखाता है कि हमें अपनी संस्कृति को संजोकर रखना चाहिए और उसे आगे बढ़ाना चाहिए। साथ ही, नई-नई नृत्य शैलियों को सीखने और अपनाने के लिए भी प्रेरित करता है। अतः आप सभी को

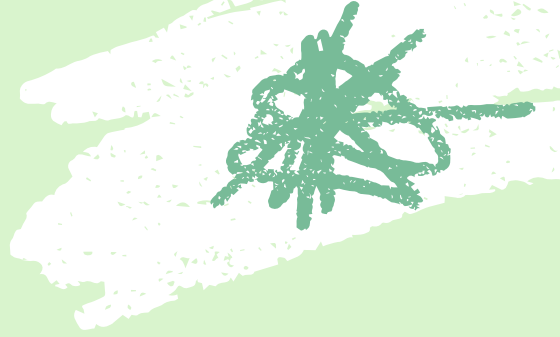

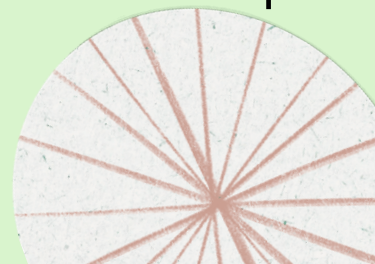

# VEG SMASH BURGERS WITH HOUSE SAUCE

## Ingredients

2 cups boiled & mashed potatoes  
½ cup grated carrot  
½ cup finely chopped cabbage or capsicum  
¼ cup peas (optional)  
2-3 tbsp breadcrumbs  
1 tsp ginger-garlic paste  
½ tsp red chili powder  
½ tsp garam masala  
Salt to taste  
2 tbsp cornflour (for binding)  
Oil or butter for cooking

## For assembling:

Burger buns  
Cheese slices (optional)  
Onion slices  
Tomato slices  
Lettuce  
Pickles (optional)

## House Sauce

½ cup mayonnaise  
2 tbsp ketchup  
1 tbsp mustard  
1 tbsp chopped pickles/relish  
1 tsp vinegar or lemon juice  
Garlic powder, paprika, salt & pepper



## Method

1. Make the mixture  
Mix everything (potato + veggies + spices + cornflour + breadcrumbs).  
Form into balls.
2. Smash & cook  
Heat a pan well.  
Place a ball and smash it thin like a tikki.  
Cook on medium-high heat until crispy and golden.  
Flip and cook the other side. Add cheese if using.
3. Toast buns  
Lightly butter and toast.
4. Assemble  
Sauce → patty → veggies → more sauce → bun top.
